Award Criteria

The following criteria will be used for determining the Jefferson Award finalists:

- 1. Activity: Describe nominee's volunteer service(s) and the need for the service(s).
- 2. Initiative: Did the nominee start a new program, initiate activities or promote collaboration with other organizations?
- 3. Impact: Describe the impact or difference the nominee's service made to our community.
- 4. Why would this individual be a good recipient of the Jefferson Award?
- 5. What amount of time and resources has the nominee donated to improve our community?

How to Apply

- 1. All nominees must be 18 years old or older.
- 2. Print legibly or type information on the nomination form.
- 3. Follow the above criteria when providing information. You may only print or type nominee information on two pages. Any additional sheets of paper will not be considered.
- 4. **Be clear and concise. Limit your nomination to 500 words or less.** Assume judges know nothing about your nominee or what he/she does for your organization.
- 5. Well-written nominations emphasizing initiative and impact score higher. If necessary, ask for help from someone who has good writing skills.
- 6. Remember to attach additional information to your submission.
